Investing in the next generation of women labor leaders is an investment in a resilient, thriving, powerful labor movement for all workers. The UC Berkeley Labor Center will host the 37th annual Western Regional Summer Institute on Union Women (SIUW) from July 10-14, 2018 at Sonoma State University. Participants develop and deepen organizing skills, train for becoming leaders in their unions, and grapple with big picture issues that the labor movement is facing. This is a rare opportunity for rank and file members, elected leaders, and staff to explore issues that affect women in the workplace and in their communities. SIUW creates lasting bonds; experienced leaders serve as mentors and role models, and younger leaders provide fresh perspectives and inspiration.
